In this class, we will play theater and movement games, sing, tell stories, play with art materials and costumes, and learn how to create and cooperate together. All of our playing and creating will build up to a final performance at the end of the session.

He is a kind, empathetic and humorous teacher who connects people with their spontaneous creativity, in words, sound and motion. He is a certified facilitator with Turning The Wheel, a national arts education organization (turningthewheel.org). He taught French and Dramatic Literature at Dickinson College in Carlisle, Pennsylvania. He teaches French at the Language Exchange, and helps facilitate an All Ages Community Dance affiliated with Portland Community Dance.
